

2013 Summer Scholarship & 2013-14 College/University Audition Form

Audition Schedule at the Alabama School of Fine Arts:

- Please use the Dorothy Jemison Day Theater entrance on 19th Street North when you arrive for Audition Check-in and/or Festival Registration Check-in.
- Scholarship Audition check-in begins in the Cafeteria at 2:00 p.m. on January 25 and is separate from Festival registration. You do not have to complete your Festival registration check-in prior to the Scholarship Audition check-in. The ABT Audition Registration will also be in the Cafeteria.
- Festival registration check-in is in ASFA's Dorothy Jemison Day Theater lobby beginning on Friday, January 25 at 1:00 p.m. Performance tickets are in the registration packets.
- Summer Scholarship Audition and College Audition for ages 15 and up is Friday, January 25, 3:00–5:00 p.m.
- Summer Scholarship Audition for age 11-14 is Friday, January 25, 5:00–7:00 p.m.

Audition Requirements:

- You must be registered for a Festival package in any track at the Alabama Dance Festival. You must register online for the Scholarship audition class and pay the additional \$30 as a part of your Festival registration. This class is not a part of your package.
- Provide two 5 x 7 photographs (B&W): 1 Headshot and 1 Body Image (your choice of position) attached to the Audition Form. Write your name, age, and phone number on the back of the photo.
- You must return this completed Audition Form with photos by January 11 17 (postmark receipt date). No materials will be accepted postmarked after this deadline and cannot be submitted at check-in. Students who do not meet this requirement will not be allowed to audition, and there will be no refunds!
- All scholarship recipients MUST commit to the completion of the full program length including the final performance if selected for a scholarship.
- ATTIRE: Women black leotards, pink tights, ballet slippers and Pointe shoes. Hair must be neatly secured/no jewelry. Men white tee shirt (tucked in), black tights/dance belt, white socks, ballet slippers. Hair must be neatly secured/no jewelry.

There will be no exceptions made to the above requirements.

Requirements for Dance Theatre of Harlem Summer Intensive Audition:

- Males & Females ages 10-24
- Pointe shoes required for intermediate and advanced levels
- Intermediate & advanced levels, bring resume and full-body shot
- Placement results are mailed within three weeks of auditions
